

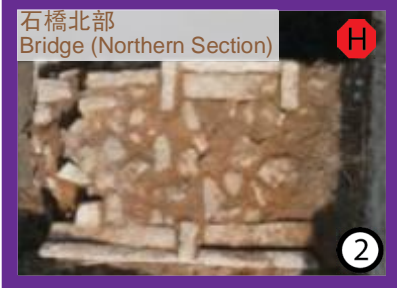
龍津石橋遺跡保育

Preservation of Lung Tsun Stone Bridge Remnants

發現的遺跡 Remnants Unearthed

2008年啟德發展計劃的環境影響評估研究進行考古調查時，發現龍津石橋遺跡。隨即展開進一步勘探工作，確認存有石橋、接官亭基石、前九龍城碼頭和1924年及30年代的海堤等遺跡。《龍津石橋保育管理計劃》的文物評估，顯示石橋和接官亭遺跡的重要性為高等級，並且建議原址保存。

The remnants of Lung Tsun Stone Bridge were discovered in 2008 during the archaeological investigation conducted under the Environmental Impact Assessment Study for the Kai Tak Development. Further investigation also identified the remnants of the original stone bridge, Pavilion for Greeting Officials, former Kowloon City Pier, 1924's and 1930's seawall segments. The heritage assessment in the Conservation Management Plan for the Bridge classifies the extant sections of the original stone bridge and the Pavilion as high significance, and recommends in-situ preservation.
