Stage 2 Public Engagement for "Building our Kai Tak River"

Consensus Building Workshop Summary of Comments and Views Collected

Objective

The objective of Stage 2 Public Engagement is to build consensus among the public on the landscape design approaches of Kai Tak River and the facilities along the riverside so as to provide a basis for the design of the River improvement works.

Upper and Mid-Stream of Kai Tak River

Morse Park

The participants agreed that the fencing of Morse Park at its interface with the River should be removed for enhancing accessibility and integration amongst the park and the River.

Nga Tsin Wai Village

The participants supported the enhancement on the continuity of access along the River in particular at the Nga Tsin Wai Village and the Tung Tau Estate.

Lower-Stream of Kai Tak River

Prince Edward Road East

The participants supported the provision of pedestrian subway across Prince Edward Road East to enhance connectivity and accessibility along the River.

Kai Tak Gateway, Station Square and Grid Neighbourhood

The participants agreed that a vibrant ambience would be more compatible with the Kai Tak Gateway and the Station Square whereas a tranquil ambience would be more suitable for the Grid Neighbourhood.

The participants agreed that space should be allowed at Station Square to cater for large pedestrian flow.

Nearshore Area and Estuary Area

The participants reckoned that there are flyovers and tunnel structures at the Estuary Area, where the development is highly constrained by these structures and will be different from the other areas along the River. An architectural feature should be provided at the Nearshore Area to demarcate the very different uses and ambience in the Estuary Area.

A direct pedestrian access should also be provided to the Estuary Area.
