Direct Access to Kai Tak Cruise Terminal and Other Key Facilities

為方便市民享用啟德發展區的公眾休 To allow better enjoyment of the public open space and to enhance the road network and connectivity in Kai Tak, the Civil Engineering and Development Department is currently constructing Road D3 (Metro Park Section). Road D3 is a dual two-lane road and the Metro Park Section (MPS) connects Shina Kai Road at the former north apron and Shing Fung Road at the former runway. The MPS is about 1,130 metres long. which includes about 200 metres of underpass, 320 metres of depressed road, 360 metres of elevated road and 250 metres of at-grade road. The works are estimated to be completed this year. By then, vehicles from the hinterland of Kai Tak (such as To Kwa Wan, Kowloon City, Wong Tai Sin) and MTR Kai Tak Station can travel more directly, without going through the busy roads in Kowloon Bay, to and from the developments at and near the former runway and former south apron, including the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal, the Hong Kong Children's Hospital and the future New Acute Hospital.

面積達15.500平方米的啟德大本 營,面向啟德明渠進口道,是海濱 長廊上其中一個最大的休憩空間。 至於佔地5.400平方米的觀賞站, 將會成為啟德河海濱與未來都會 公園的主要連接點。

Abundant Public Open Space along the Waterfront

To provide greater convenience for the public to enjoy views of the harbour and the precinct, various sections of public open space will undergo different developments. They include the Kai Tak Basecamp (an area near the head of the Kai Tak Approach Channel) and the Viewing Station (located on the landscaped deck above Road D3 (MPS)), both to be completed by 2023 tentatively.

Facing the Kai Tak Approach Channel, the 15,500 m² Kai Tak Basecamp is one of the largest pieces of open space along the promenade. Meanwhile, the 5,400 m² Viewing Station serves as a main connecting point between the waterfront at the Kai Tak Approach Channel and the future Metro Park.

The Kai Tak Basecamp and the Viewing Station are equipped with a diverse range of facilities to provide visitors with different experiences.

Kai Tak Basecamp

- Connection Deck cum Light Refreshment Kiosk The circular viewing deck features an eight-metrewide elevated walkway linking the vehicular Road D3 (MPS) Bridge, as well as a circular ramp providing barrier-free access
- Amphitheatre The stepped seating ensures unobstructed views of performances
- Water Play Plaza Equipped with a special dry floor fountain and a rain garden that can treat and collect
- Multi-purpose and Seating Areas The area under the vehicular Road D3 (MPS) Bridge is not only a venue for events, but it also connects the Kai Tak Basecamp with Kai Tak Sports Park and the future Metro Park




Ith an area of 28 hectares, Kai Tak Sports Park (the Sports Park) is one of the redevelopment plans of the former Kai Tak Airport. The Sports Park is integrated with multi-purpose and quality sports facilities for international sports competitions and large-scale events to fully support the development of sports. The Sports Park is equipped with different community facilities such as public open spaces, children's playground, wellness centre as well as retail and dining outlets for public enjoyment. It is poised to be the largest sports and leisure new destination as well as a tourist attraction in Hong Kong upon completion.

可容納50,000名觀眾的主場館,配備開合式上蓋和靈活的草坪系統,在任何天氣情況下,均可舉行各種大型的體育盛事。可轉換的舞台位置及座位配置,能適合舉辦不同規模的休閒及社區活動。

為建造一個屬於香港的地標, 主場館以「東方之珠」為設計 意念,配合外牆的珍珠色調, 令主場館看似一顆坐落於啟德 海濱的耀眼明珠。



The 50,000-seat Main Stadium will have a retractable roof and a flexible pitch surface, offering an all-weather venue for major sports events. The customisable staging and seating configurations also allow it to host leisure activities as well as community events of different scales.

To create a landmark unique to Hong Kong, the "Pearl of the Orient" has been adopted as the façade design theme of the Main Stadium. With its pearl-like external wall, the Main Stadium will become an immense and iridescent "pearl" on the Kai Tak harbourfront promenade.



A Sustainable, Accessible Sports Park

The design of the Sports Park has incorporated various environmentally conscious design, such as photovoltaic panels (PV), extensive roof greening and electric vehicle charging stations.


The Sports Park will be linked up with its surrounding areas by direct and convenient pedestrian connections. In particular, it will only take approximately 10 minutes to walk from the Main Stadium to the MTR Kai Tak and Sung Wong Toi Stations.

除此之外,團隊更將於今年底,在 啟德車站廣場舉行一個運動共融嘉 年華,透過遊戲攤位、表演及示範、 運動工作坊、比賽和新興運動體驗 等,與眾同樂!

Integration of Sports, History and Culture

Kai Tak Sports Park and its Community Project "Kai Tak Sports Initiative" ("the team") have launched a series of "Heritage Run in 18 districts" earlier. "Kowloon City Run" was the first activity of the series co-organised together with the Kowloon City District Office and the Antiquities and Monuments Office (AMO) to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR). The routes include "Kowloon City – Kowloon Tong Heritage Run", "Kai Tak Promenade Run" and "To Kwa Wan Factory Tour", etc. Participants were guided by professional coaches through the historical sites and scenic spots in the area, while listening to docents about the history and stories of the monuments.
