

# STATE-OF-THE-ART SPORTS **INFRASTRUCTURE**

Undoubtedly, the Kai Tak Sports Park will be the biggest sports infrastructure project by the Government in recent decades. Scattering over the spacious Park, there will be a mixture of high quality sports venues and facilities, open space, park features, as well as retail and dining outlets for different kinds of major events and local community enjoyment. The three main high standard multi-purpose facilities are the main stadium, indoor sports centre and public sports ground, each with different capacity and functionality.

# **Main Stadium**

With a seating capacity of around 50 000 and being made adaptable to different sports and recreational events, the main stadium will attract the world's top players of various international tournaments, including football and rugby, and thousands of fans from every corner of the world to gather here in town. Apart from being thrilled by the amazing skills and prowess of athletes, people can also enjoy other leisure and entertainment activities like concerts, carnivals and large-scale community events at the main stadium.

This multi-functional stadium will be equipped with a flexible turf system and have different configurations to meet the needs of different sports and entertainment events. The removable pitch management system can add flexibility while the retractable roof can help mitigate noise impact on nearby residents. Spectators' experience in terms of sightlines and viewing distances are catered for without affecting the functional versatility of the stadium.

# **Indoor Sports Centre**

Imagine about 7 000 spectators cheering at the same time for a competition, everyone will be overwhelmed with excitement. With a playing surface equivalent to around 40 standard badminton courts when all retractable seats are retracted, the indoor sports centre can also become an ideal venue for community badminton, basketball, volleyball and other indoor sports activities during non-event days.



# **Public Sports Ground**

"On your mark, get set, go!" The public sports ground with a seating capacity of about 5 000 will be where you can cheer for your kids competing on the school sports day. This public sports ground will be also a place for hosting local football matches, and open to the public for jogging and exercising at leisure time.

# **Ancillary Facilities**

The Kai Tak Sports Park will take up the role of more than just providing high quality sports venues. The over-7-hectare-large open space will offer a landscaped park with extensive greening, fun-filled playgrounds, fitness stations, jogging and cycling tracks and more . It is a place for the children to have fun, the active to jog, and the health-conscious to work out.

More supporting facilities including a health and wellness centre for treatments on sports injuries and health improvement, retail outlets and restaurants are also proposed for the Park.

# 主場館



# 新東九龍總區總部及 行動基地暨牛頭角分區警署

# **NEW KOWLOON EAST REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS AND OPERATIONAL BASE-CUM-**NGAU TAU KOK DIVISIONAL POLICE STATION

為配合政府把東九龍轉型為主要的商業、旅遊及康樂樞紐的計 劃,警務處有必要增強警政服務,以滿足區內持續增加的人口

有見及此,東九龍總區總部及行動基地暨牛頭角分區警署(下 稱東九龍總部綜合大樓)的興建工程已於今年7月展開,預計 於2019年第四季完成。位於前北面停機坪協調道105號的東 九龍總部綜合大樓佔地約6600平方米,樓高18層,負責東九 龍總區的整體行動、刑事調查、交通管理、警民關係和行政事 宜,並監督總區、警區和分區層面的日常警務工作。

新建的東九龍總部綜合大樓,把警務處東九龍總區轄下的各單 位集合其中,以加強現時東九龍總區的整體指揮,並提升行動 效率,使警隊更能應付將來東九龍總區內的挑戰。

Pursuant to the Government's commitment to transform Kowloon East into a major commercial, tourism and recreational hub, there is a need for an enhanced and strategic police presence to provide police services to the increasing population and commercial activities in the region.

Construction of the new 18-storey integrated complex of Kowloon East Regional Headquarters and Operational Base-cum-Ngau Tau Kok Divisional Police Station (KERHQ Complex) commenced in July this year for completion in the fourth quarter of 2019. With an area of around 6 600 square metres, the KERHQ Complex is located at the former north apron area of Kai Tak at 105 Concorde Road. It is responsible for the overall operations, criminal investigations, traffic management, community relations and administrative matters for the Kowloon East Region and overseeing the daily policing at regional, district and divisional levels.

By co-locating various Kowloon East Regional units under the new integrated complex, the overall command of police resources will be strengthened and the operational efficiency will be much enhanced thereby allowing the police to better cope with future challenges in Kowloon East
